Visitor Guidelines for Heritage Green Nursing Home

Welcome to Heritage Green Nursing Home. The safety and well-being of our residents, staff, and visitors are our top priorities. Please follow these infection control guidelines during your visit:

General Guidelines

- **Screening**: All visitors must complete a self-screening for symptoms before entering. Do not visit if you are feeling unwell.
- **Hand Hygiene**: Clean your hands with hand sanitizer upon entry, before and after contact with residents, and when leaving.
- Masking & PPE: Follow current public health guidance on mask use. Masks may be required in certain areas or during outbreaks.
- **Physical Distancing**: Maintain a safe distance from residents and staff where possible, especially in communal areas.
- Visitation Areas: Visits may take place in designated areas, resident rooms, or outdoors, as appropriate.
- Outbreak Protocols: If an outbreak occurs, visitation may be restricted or modified to protect residents. Follow staff instructions during these times.

Special Considerations

- Essential caregivers and support persons may have additional access based on resident needs.
- Children are welcome but must be supervised at all times and adhere to infection control measures.
- Pets may be permitted with prior approval and must meet health and safety requirements.
